It's easy to become an Aquarium Collector with Ollie's Trading Post!

- 1 Get out and explore: Find approved natural artifacts in your surroundings. Make sure the artifacts are okay for you to collect! (see *Do's and Don'ts* below)
- 2 If you have not already, go online to scaquarium.org to download the Trading Post Collector Record.
- 3 Research your natural artifact to become an expert collector!
- 4 Bring your artifact and completed Trading Post Collector Record to Ollie's Trading Post exhibit to earn points and interact with the Aquarium's Education team. The more points you earn, the more you can trade and collect for other cool items like shark teeth, fossils and much more!
- 5 For extra points, bring in recyclable items. Items accepted:
 - ▶ Bottle Caps (minimum of 100 caps)
 - ▶ Batteries (minimum of 50 batteries)
 - ▶ Natural wine corks (minimum of 25 corks)
 - ▶ Old cell phones (no minimum)
 - ▶ Ink cartridges (no minimum)

Do's and Don'ts

DO

- ▶ Bring in up to 2 approved natural artifacts per day to the Trading Post
- ▶ Research your natural artifact online or at the library first before your visit
- ▶ Respect all wildlife, habitats and private property when collecting

DON'T

- ▶ Collect natural artifacts that are not allowed at the trading post, such as bird items, live animals, items from endangered or protected species or wildflowers
- ▶ Over collect artifacts – only collect 1 or 2 of the same type of artifact
