At the grand opening of the South Carolina Aquarium in 2000, Mayor Joseph P. Riley, Jr. likened the Aquarium to a cathedral. He referenced the practice, dating back to early civilizations, of communities rising unified to construct monuments to something larger than themselves. 
conservation awareness that stretches far beyond our immediate natural environment.


