Local seafood is the focus of the Good Catch program. We define local to include the southeastern regional fisheries (North Carolina to Florida), with priority given to South Carolina fisheries. Supporting local fisheries supports the local economy and is the most sustainable option because it produces the smallest carbon footprint with the fewest miles travelled. Additionally, local seafood is a healthier option as it is a fresher product and comes from waters that are closely monitored for ecosystem health.

I agree to one of the following Good Catch Partner levels:

- **Basic** Partner: At least 1/3 of our annual seafood inventory will be locally sourced.*
- **Gold** Partner: At least 1/2 of our annual seafood inventory will be locally sourced.*
- **Platinum** Partner: At least 1/2 of our annual seafood inventory will be locally sourced* and we agree to follow the standards set by South Carolina Aquarium single-use plastic reduction initiative.

Outside of "local," seafood should be sourced from purveyors providing sustainable seafood or come from sustainable sources.

I agree to pay the annual \$200 partnership fee within 30 days of being invoiced. If I do not pay the annual partnership fee, I understand that my membership to Good Catch will be discontinued and my business' name will be removed from all promotional materials.
